1. Contractor - HVAC Technician

Reporting to the Maintenance Coordinator – HVAC & Plumbing, the individual has functional responsibility for providing maintenance and operational services in the HVAC area in a 24-hour operational environment.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Diploma/Associate Degree in Engineering or equivalent **OR**
- Any combination of training and experience equivalent to grade 10 or higher level graduation and four (4) years' experience in any or a combination of the following disciplines namely maintenance and repair/upkeep of air conditioning units, building systems, electrical distribution systems and equipment, cable pressurization systems, plumbing and repair operations **PLUS**
- National Vocational Qualification of Jamaica Level 2 in A/C Refrigeration, and a valid General Driver's Licence.

Required Skills and Specialized Techniques:

- Experience in chilled water HVAC systems, troubleshooting and repair of faults with chillers, compressors, pumps, air handling and Fan Coil units.
- Experience in servicing mini-split and air-conditioning units, and basic knowledge of refrigeration/cooling cycle.
- Sound practical and theoretical knowledge of the principles of electricity and a/c circuits, and methods of preventative maintenance.
- Knowledge of materials, methods and equipment used in the maintenance, repair and improvement of the facilities of a modern airport, and sound knowledge of safety rules, regulations and procedures.

2. Plumber – Grade II

Reporting to the Maintenance Coordinator – HVAC & Plumbing, the individual has functional responsibility for providing plumbing maintenance and operational services in a 24-hour operational environment.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Diploma/Associate Degree in Engineering or equivalent **OR**
- Any combination of training and experience equivalent to grade 10 or higher level graduation and four (4) years' experience in the maintenance and upkeep of buildings, building systems, pipe fitting, plumbing and repair operations **PLUS**
- National Vocational Qualification of Jamaica Level 2.

Required Skills and Specialized Techniques:

- Expert knowledge of the operation and maintenance of sewage and industrial pumping systems.
- Sound knowledge of the operation and maintenance of fire suppression systems.
- Sound knowledge of troubleshooting techniques and repairs, and principles and methods of preventative maintenance
- Sound knowledge of sanitation, housekeeping and cleaning techniques.
- Working knowledge of materials, methods and equipment used in the maintenance, repair and improvement of a modern air carrier airport (SIA).
- Sound knowledge of relevant safety rules, regulations and procedures.

Candidates for these positions must possess a valid general driver's licence; the ability to communicate effectively with fellow employees, airport management, regulatory staff, tenants and concessionaires.

3. Operations Centre Coordinator
