Jamaica Welcomes Condor's Resumption of Scheduled Service from Frankfurt, Germany

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 04 July 2021 // Sangster International Airport (SIA), Jamaica's leading gateway to the world operated by MBJ Airports Limited, welcomed Condor's resumption of twice weekly scheduled service from Frankfurt, Germany.

Germany's most popular holiday carrier 'Condor Airlines' resumed scheduled flights from Frankfurt Airport, Germany via Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic to Sangster International Airport, Montego Bay, Jamaica on Sunday, July 4, 2021. The twice weekly frequencies from Frankfurt will operate Sundays and Wednesdays.

The inaugural flight DE2144 operated using B767 aircraft, arrived at Sangster International Airport from Frankfurt via Puerto Plata on Sunday, July 4, 2021, at 4:08 p.m. carrying 188 passengers and 10 crew members. This twice weekly service marks Condor's return to Jamaica since March of 2020 when the COVID-19 pandemic resulted in Germany being one of Jamaica's first direct route to have been impacted by the suspension of service due to announced travel restrictions.

The arriving flight was greeted by a celebratory water arch salute from MBJ's Emergency Response Service team and disembarking passengers were greeted by a cadre of tourism officials and the lively sounds of Jamaican Mento music performed live by a local Mento Band.

Mr. Ralf Teckentrup, CEO of Condor stated that "The desire to travel is huge and responsible travelling is also possible these days thanks to comprehensive protection and hygiene measures along the entire journey. Condor will be flying twice weekly to Jamaica from July onwards, heralding the start of a summer in which people no longer have to dream of travelling with a clear conscience, but can relax on the dream beaches on site."

MBJ Airports Limited's Chief Executive Officer, Shane Munroe is also pleased with the resumption of this service, "We are excited by the return of Condor's twice weekly service to Sangster International Airport after the forced hiatus. We are happy to see our European guests from our second largest market out of Europe turn their long-awaited Island getaway dreams into a well-deserved reality."
