Additional Flight Operations Tuesday July 2, 2024 due to Hurricane Beryl

Montego Bay, Jamaica – July 2, 2024 2:30 P.M.

The Sangster International Airport will temporarily close tonight, Tuesday, July 2, at 11:59 PM and remain closed throughout Wednesday, July 3, 2024.

To ensure visitors can depart the island prior to the impact of the hurricane, the following **Additional Flights** will operate today, Tuesday July 2, 2024. Passengers are urged to contact their airline to make changes to their reservations prior to making their way to the airport.
