Avelo Airlines Announces Nonstop Service Between Montego Bay and Hartford, Connecticut

Introductory one-way fares between MBJ and Hartford start at \$178

MONTEGO BAY, Jamaica; July 24, 2024 – As part of the largest expansion in company history, Avelo Airlines announced today it will launch its first scheduled international route this fall between Jamaica's Sangster International Airport (MBJ) and Hartford's Bradley International Airport (BDL). Avelo is the only airline offering nonstop service between Montego Bay and the capital region of Connecticut.

Beginning November 16, 2024, Avelo will operate this route twice weekly on Wednesdays and Saturdays, utilizing Boeing Next-Generation 737 aircraft. Introductory one-way fares between MBJ and BDL start at \$178*. Travelers can make reservations at AveloAir.com.
